

Blown fuse in circuit breaker in Denmark

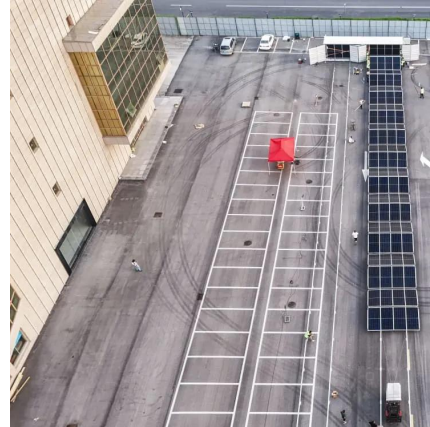

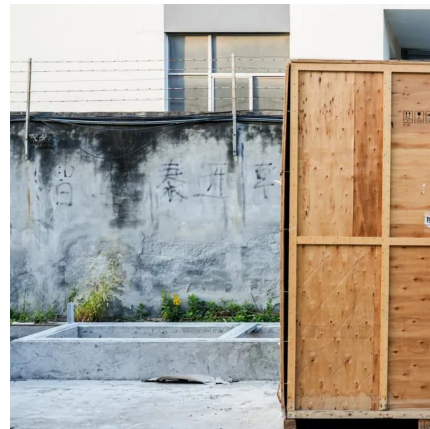
