Overview

Who will build a solar PV plant in Côte d'Ivoire?

Abidjan, Côte d'Ivoire, August 7th, 2025 – IFC and the Government of Côte d'Ivoire today announced Infinity Power Holding as the winning bidder to design, finance, build, and operate two grid-connected solar PV plants in Côte d'Ivoire.

When will a solar power plant open in Côte d'Ivoire?

In the northern region of the Côte d'Ivoire, the first phase of a solar power facility has been officially opened. The Boundiali solar power plant's financing was initially revealed in 2018, and details of its commissioning were made public in December 2022.

Will Côte d'Ivoire get more solar power?

The project will help Côte d'Ivoire reach its goal of increasing the country's share of renewable energy to 42 percent by 2030 from only about 1 percent currently. By introducing more Solar PV capacity, Côte d'Ivoire is diversifying its energy mix while developing a more resilient energy sector.

How many solar plants are there in Côte d'Ivoire?

Additionally, Coulibaly mentioned plans to build seven more plants. These solar plants are 50 MWp in Tengréla, 50 MWp in Kong, 25 MWp in Sérébou, 60 MWp in Touba and Loba, 50 MWp in Odienné, 50 MWp in Mankono, and 25 MWp in Soubré. In the northern region of the Côte d'Ivoire, the first phase of a solar power facility has been officially opened.






