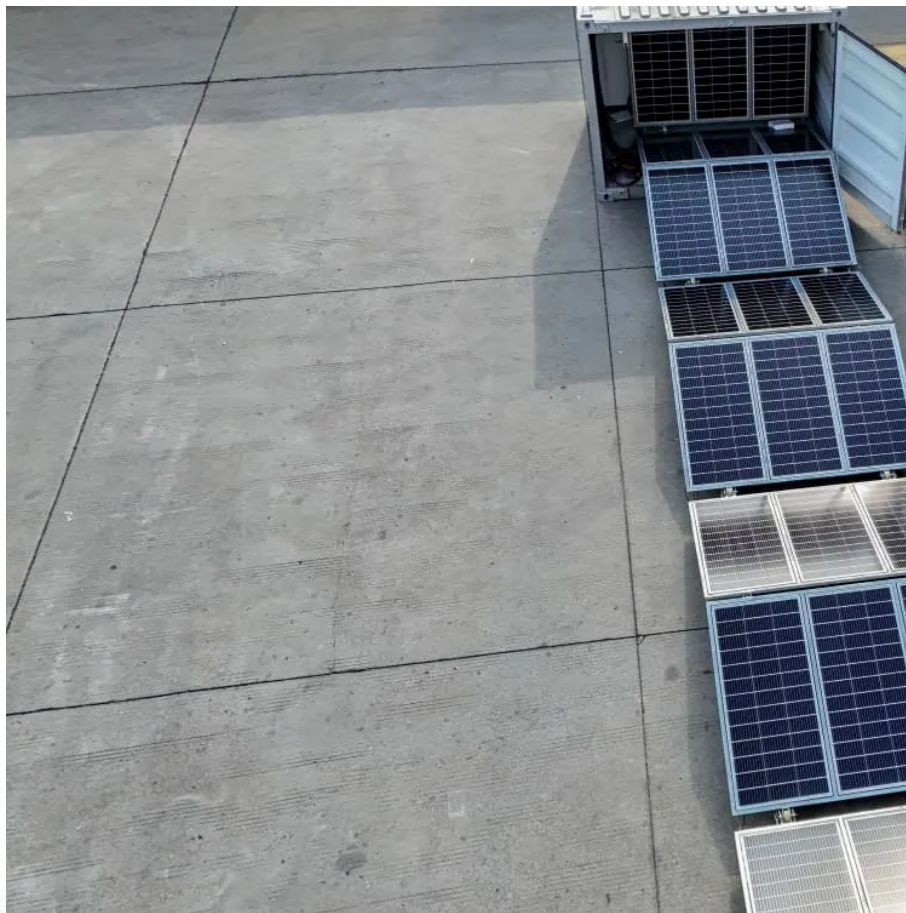

Vitamin B-6

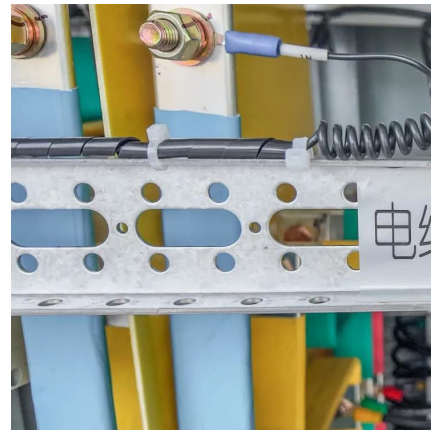

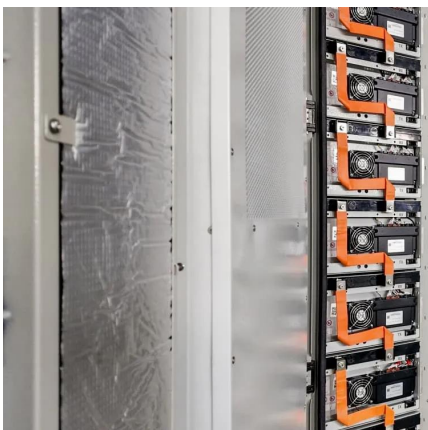

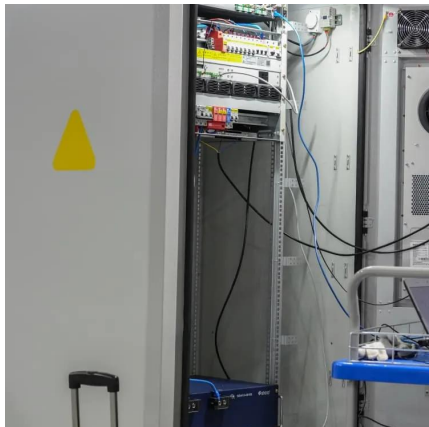
