Overview

Are there subsidies for solar panels in Singapore?

In Singapore, there are no direct subsidies for residential solar panel installation. However, homeowners and businesses can still monetise excess solar energy through sell-back schemes that allow them to export unused electricity to the national grid. These are often mislabelled as “net metering,” but Singapore does not use a net metering model.

Are solar panels a good investment in Singapore?

As of 2025, Singapore households and businesses are showing growing interest in solar panel subsidies, especially with new schemes like Net-Metering and Rent-to-Own gaining attention. If you’re considering solar energy, understanding these government-backed incentives is crucial to maximize savings and sustainability.

How much support do solar panels get in Singapore?

The level of support you can receive depends on the Green Mark certification level and the carbon emissions reduction achieved through energy improvements. In Singapore, there are no direct subsidies for residential solar panel installation.

Do Singaporeans get subsidies for child care & infant care?

All families with a Singaporean child attending childcare and infant care programmes receive the Basic Subsidy. For more families to enjoy higher pre-school subsidies, the Government raised the monthly income ceiling for additional subsidies from \$7,500 to \$12,000 from 2020.


